This order is entered to establish minimum requirements for listing creditors and parties in interest on mailing matrices for both conventionally filed (paper) cases and electronically filed cases. Clerk's Instruction 1007-1(a) to South Carolina Local Bankruptcy Rule 1007-1 will be amended accordingly.

The list of creditors (mailing matrix) shall include all creditors and parties in interest entitled to notice of the particular case for which it is being filed. It is not necessary to include the debtor, joint debtor, attorney for debtor, case trustee or United States Trustee in the list of creditors since these will be automatically added through the court's Case Management/Electronic Case Filing (CM/ECF) system.

The following should be included on the matrix under the conditions noted:

IN ALL CASES

Any equity security holder, indenture trustee, governmental entity, or any other creditor or party in interest entitled to receive notice pursuant to Title 11, United States Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and/or any other federal and state statutes and authorities regarding requirements for notice.

IN CASES IN WHICH THE DEBTOR OWES STATE OR LOCAL TAXES:

City Tax Collector (of the city in which the debtor resides) and full address

County Tax Collector (of the county in which the debtor resides) and full address


