<u>POSITION</u>: The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina is seeking applicants to fill either one full-time or two part-time (20 hours per week) judicial law clerk positions. The term of employment is expected to be one to four years. The position qualifies for employment benefits. The law clerk would be assigned to Chief Judge John E. Waites and may be stationed in Columbia or Charleston at the discretion of the Judge. Judicial law clerks are primarily responsible for legal research and the preparation of orders, memoranda and drafting of opinions. Some travel may be required.

<u>QUALIFICATIONS</u>: To qualify for the position of law clerk, the applicant must be a law school graduate and possess excellent research, writing and computer skills. Journal or Law Review experience preferred. Bar membership is required for salary placement above a grade JSP 11.

Appointment at a JSP grade 12 (\$65,315) requires qualifications for JSP 11 plus at least 1 full-time equivalent year of legal work experience gained after graduation from law school and bar membership.

Appointment at a JSP grade 13 (\$77,670) requires qualifications for JSP 11 plus 2 full-time equivalent years of legal work experience gained after graduation from law school and bar membership.

Appointment at a JSP grade 14 (\$91,781) requires qualification for JSP 11 plus at least 3

full-time equivalent years of legal work experience gained after graduation from law school and bar membership. At least 2 of the 3 full-time years of legal experience must have been as a law clerk or staff attorney in a federal court.

Salary will be based upon experience and qualifications in accordance with JSP guidelines.
