

# Upcoming Changes to Court Hearings Calendars

## When will the changes occur?

- June 10, 2026 for Judge Davis’s cases
- July 21, 2026 for Judge Burris and Judge Gasparini’s cases

## What are the upcoming changes?

### Changing Slot Numbers:

- On the court’s website, the hearing slot numbers will no longer be static and will change leading up to the hearing date as other matters are added or removed.
  - Removed hearings will be placed at the end of the time slot.
  - Generally, slot numbers will not be finalized until the afternoon before the hearing date once all calendar removal requests are processed and those hearings removed.
    - **Parties need to file calendar removal requests before the deadline in the Common Chambers Guidelines.**
- Below is an example of how the calendar will be reorganized after a hearing removal request is granted.

*Calendar before hearings removal:*

*Calendar after hearings removal:*

- Removal of slot #2 and #3 (25-04786) due to a continuance order causes them to move to the end of the docket’s time slot.

- Slot #4 (26-01368) becomes slot #2, and the hearings for 25-04786 become slot #3 and #4.
- Because slot number 5 (26-00422) is in a different time slot, it remains unchanged with the removal of hearings at 10:00 AM.

**CM/ECF Event Changes:**

The following CM/ECF events currently require filers to input the slot number when the filing relates to a hearing on the calendar to assist the courtroom deputy in identifying the subject hearing:

- Request to Continue (Text Only)
- Withdrawal from Court Calendar (Text Only)
- Calendar Removal Request
- Calendar Removal Request – Confirmation Hearing Only
- Request for Remote Appearance
- Notice of Settlement and Request for Removal from Hearing Calendar
- Notice of Pleading for Upcoming Hearing

Because slot numbers will be dynamic, these events will be modified to remove the input of slot numbers. Instead, **parties will be required to link to the relevant pleading and hearing notice.**

As part of the transition to the new system, these events will have both the slot number input screen and the linking to the pleading from early June to mid-July. Once all judges have moved to the new system, the slot number input screen will be removed.
