

Chapter 13 Confirmation Orders

- C-I** The plan as presently filed on _____ may be confirmed if the trustee recommends confirmation. If the plan is not confirmed, a continued confirmation hearing will be held on _____ at _____ a.m./p.m. The debtor(s) is/are given ten (10) days from the date of this Order within which to provide the Chapter 13 trustee with any documents and information requested at or before the confirmation hearing. If the debtor fails to comply with the terms of this Order, this case may be dismissed without further notice or hearing.
- C-II** The plan does not currently comply with the requirements for confirmation. The debtor(s) is/are given ten (10) days from the date of this Order within which to propose, file, and serve a modified plan pursuant to SC LBR 3015-2, and/or to provide the Chapter 13 trustee with any documents and information requested at or before the confirmation hearing. Any other conditions incident to confirmation which may have been orally approved by the Court during the hearing are hereby made a part of this Order. If the debtor(s) fail(s) to comply with the requirements of these conditions as ordered, the case may be dismissed without further notice or hearing. The plan, or any modified plan, may be confirmed without further notice or a hearing if there are no objections and the Trustee recommends confirmation.
- C-III A** The plan does not comply with the requirements of Chapter 13. Therefore, confirmation is denied and the case is hereby dismissed.
- C-III B** The plan does not comply with the requirements of Chapter 13. Therefore, confirmation is denied and the case is hereby dismissed with prejudice based upon a previous Order directing that any dismissal of this case would be with prejudice. The debtor(s) is/are hereby directed not to file a Petition under <Chapter 13 **OR** Chapters 11, 12, and 13> for a period of <one-hundred eighty (180) days **OR** one year> from entry of this Order.
- C-IV** Confirmation of the plan is denied. The case will be dismissed unless a motion to convert to another chapter is filed within ten (10) days.
