	Deleted unnecessary portions and moved sections to other provisions of the Local Rules (see table).
SC LBR 9011-1	<b>ATTORNEYS - DUTIES</b>
	This is a renumbered Rule. Additionally cites competency requirements of attorneys appearing before the Court.
SC LBR 9013-3	<b>CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE</b>
	Removed multiple references throughout Rules to a certificate of service requirement and consolidated the requirement into 9013-3.
SC LBR 9013-4	<b>MOTIONS ON PASSIVE NOTICE</b>
	Limited availability for passive notice on motions to extend time to object to discharge and dischargeability to the first request.
SC LBR 9015-1	<b>JURY TRIALS</b>
	Added deemed waiver of objection to a motion for jury trial upon failure to seek to withdraw reference.
SC LBR 9029-1	<b>OPERATING ORDERS, GUIDELINES REGARDING CASE MANAGEMENT, AND AMENDMENTS TO THE LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES</b>
	Clarified procedure by which amendments to the Rules may be made.
