

3.0 Features List

Claims:

- Claims - amended claims will not receive a new claim number, but rather an extension of the original claim (e.g. claim is 2 and amended claim is 2.1).
- Claims history may be enhanced.
- The Claims Register will be accessible from the "Query" screen.
- Notices of Electronic Claims filing will now include link to the claims register and Notice of Electronic Claims.

Petitions/Documents:

- Opening an bankruptcy case: When determining the type of debtor, check boxes will be changed to radio buttons and only *one* can be chosen.
- When opening Adversary Proceedings, more than one Nature of Suit can be designated. Designation of role types are no longer required.
- Duplicate docket entries will be avoided when a user accidentally clicks "submit" twice.
- Other minor modifications are included.

Public Access:

- Public Access Enhancements: 3.0 contains an ability to remove association between current PACER login and filer login
- Docket activity will be accessible via the Internet and can be filtered for specific cases.
- Transcripts will now be exempt from the 30-page billing limit.
- More precise Party/Person searches can be performed with first/middle names rather than just the last name.

Utilities/Miscellaneous:

- **Important Note: If you have a "~" (tilda) in your password, change your password to remove as 3.0 will not recognize the password as valid.**
- Release 3.0 is designed to work with Netscape 7.2 and Internet Explorer 6 and may not function correctly with earlier versions of these browsers.
- Various technical fixes are also included.

Note: Other features may be implemented at a later date, following the Court's upcoming mandatory upgrade to 3.1 by October 17, 2006. External user training may be required and information will be forthcoming.
