ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Chief Judge of the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina issued an Order providing that, in addition to the federal holiday of Friday, July 3, 2026, the District Court will be closed on Monday, July 6, 2026, in further recognition of the United States Semiquincentennial. This additional day will be treated the same as a federal holiday for the purpose of computing time under the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Local Rules,¹ and any applicable statute. The Bankruptcy Court, as a division of the District Court, will follow that Order with the limited exception that the Columbia courthouse location will be open with limited staff onsite on July 6, 2026, to accept *pro se* filings.² The Greenville and Charleston courthouse locations will be closed that day. CM/ECF will remain available for attorney filings.³
