

ORDER

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina will be closed on Friday, November 28, 2003 (the day after Thanksgiving Day) and on Friday, December 26, 2003, (the day after Christmas Day).

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9006(a), since the day after Thanksgiving and the day after Christmas are legal holidays of the State of South Carolina, they will not be included in the computation of any period of time prescribed or allowed by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure made applicable by the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, by the local rules, by order of court, or by any applicable statute. If November 28, 2003, is the last day of a period of time described in the preceding sentence, the period will run until Monday, December 1, 2003, and if December 26, 2003, is the last day of a period of time described in the preceding sentence, the period will run until Monday, December 29, 2003.
