The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina has an opening for an intern. The Court's Internship Program demonstrates a commitment to the community and the Court will select one or more qualified candidates to serve in a non-compensated position in our Information Technology department. This offering will give the selected individual advanced knowledge and experience in the technical field and expose him or her to various areas of technology with the focus of the position on web development. Educational credit may be possible depending on the requirements of the individual's educational institution.

SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM AND DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The Court will migrate from a currently locally hosted website to a nationally hosted virtual server. The Court will provide all required tools and resources needed to successfully perform this migration project. The project duration is unknown at this time but involves a detailed analysis of the Court's existing website, server infrastructure and customized back-end applications. The intern will suggest the look, layout and features of the Court's website utilizing nationalized templates. This internship involves understanding of both graphic design and computer programming and the selected candidate will collaborate with the entire Information Technology team at various levels. This program will focus on the following technologies: 1) database communications; 2) web scripting, programming; 3) image manipulation; 4) multimedia design; 5) HTML Web development language; 5) content management; and 6) multimedia programming and technology.

QUALIFICATIONS: The ideal candidate would be currently pursuing a Computer Science or related degree and possess the following qualifications: 1) familiarity working with the LAMP stack (Linux/Apache/MySQL/PHP); 2) familiarity with IIS (Windows Server 2008R2); 3) experience with the Object-Oriented Programming; 4) understanding of relational databases and experience constructing SQL statements; 5) understanding and familiarity with HTML/CSS, AJAX and XML; 6) good interpersonal skills and a passion for problem-solving; 7) experience building a website. Preferred additional qualifications include familiarity or experience with the following: 1) Drupal and Dreamweaver; 2) Adobe Photoshop; 3) Database management; 4) Javascript; 5) understanding of HTML5/CSS3; 6) Responsive Design; and 7) C#.Net framework
