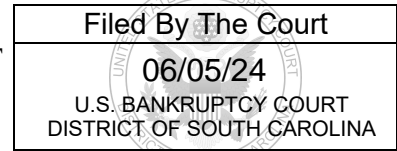

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

This Court is authorized to promulgate local rules pursuant to Local Civ. Rule 83.IX.02 (D.S.C.). Title 28 U.S.C. § 2077(b) states that “[e]ach court, except the Supreme Court, that is authorized to prescribe rules of conduct of such court’s business under section 2071 of this title shall appoint an advisory committee for the study of the rules of practice and internal operating procedures of such court . . .” On February 15, 2023, the Court appointed eleven practitioners to serve on the Court’s advisory committee (the “Committee”) for a two-year term. One committee member relocated out of state and resigned from the Committee; accordingly, Suzanne Campbell Chisholm is appointed to fill the vacancy and serve on the Court’s advisory committee. For the remainder of the two-year term that began on February 15, 2023, the persons listed below will serve on the Court’s advisory committee for the purpose of considering local rules, practice, and procedures.¹
