HOLIDAY CLOSING OF THE COURT

AMENDED ORDER

The Chief Judge of the United States District Court for the District of South Carolina issued an Order providing that, in addition to the legal holidays of Thursday, November 27, 2025, Thursday, December 25, 2025, and Thursday, January 1, 2026, the District Court will be closed the following days:

Thanksgiving:	Wednesday, November 26, 2025 Friday, November 28, 2025
Christmas:	Wednesday, December 24, 2025 Friday, December 26, 2025
New Year's:	Friday, January 2, 2026

These additional days will be treated the same as a federal holiday for the purpose of computing any period of time prescribed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Local Rules,¹ and any applicable statute. The Bankruptcy Court, as a division of the District Court, will follow that Order with the limited exception that the Columbia courthouse will be open with a limited staff onsite on November 28, 2025, to accept *pro se* filings.² The Greenville and Charleston courthouses will be closed that day. CM/ECF will remain available for attorney filings.³
