**REGARDING OPERATING  
ORDER 20-06**

On April 1, 2020, in response to the national health emergency involving the 2019 novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and the considerable financial impact thereof, the judges of this Court collectively implemented Operating Order 20-06, *Interim Procedures for Relief to Mitigate the Effects of COVID-19*. As the title indicates, a limited duration was intended. While the Court acknowledges that COVID-19 effects linger and the judges of the Court and trustees may continue to respond to delinquencies and other controversies with leniency on a case-by-case basis, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Operating Order 20-06 is abrogated effective March 27, 2022.<sup>1</sup>
